CMS Email Title & Release Date	Release of CY 2023 Bid Review OOPC Model – New Generics – Dated 06/21/2022
Summary	CMS is announcing the release of the 2023 Bid Review OOPC Model that accounts for the newly added generic drugs to the CY 2023 May Formulary Reference File (FRF).

CMS Memo Title & Release Date	Clarification of the Special Enrollment Period (SEP) for Government Entity-Declared Disaster or Other Emergency – Dated 06/22/2022
Summary	CMS reminds plans that on May 5, 2020 , it was announced that the COVID-19 pandemic could be eligible for the "SEP for Individuals Affected by a FEMA-Declared Weather-Related Emergency or Major Disaster". The SEP was available from the start of the incident period — defined as the effective date of March 1, 2020 , and for four full calendar months thereafter, ending June 30, 2020 . CMS did not extend the SEP beyond this period. It is advised plans take action to ensure the correct application of the criteria for SEPs. The criteria for new emergency declarations after January 1, 2021 , can be found in regulation at 42 CFR § 422.62(b)(18) for MA and at § 423.38(c)(23) for Part D. Summary	CMS released a memorandum to provide plan sponsors with information and guidance regarding how people qualify for LIS. Part D sponsors should encourage individuals to apply for LIS and assist with the process.

CMS Memo Title & Release Date	Rerun of Payment Year (PY) 2015 - Deadline Extension – Dated 06/24/2022

Summary	CMS has received plan requests to extend the deadline for delete submissions. CMS will accommodate these requests and is extending the deadline. The deadline to submit all PY 2015 (2014 dates of service) deletions to the Risk Adjustment Processing System (RAPS) is now extended to 8:00 p.m. ET, Thursday, July 14, 2022 . Further extensions will not be possible, so please plan accordingly. We anticipate that this rerun will be reflected in the October 2022 monthly payment.

Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CMS continues to implement software improvements to the systems related to accepting and processing encounter data to support the Medicare Advantage (MA) program. The change described in this memo impacts an existing edit (Edit 21925 - “Swing Bed SNF Conditions Not Met”) within the Encounter Data Processing System (EDPS) and is effective for submissions beginning July 1, 2022.

CMS Memo Title & Release Date	Encounter Data Front End System Software Release Updates: 2022 Quarter 3 Release– Dated 06/29/2022
Summary	<p>The changes listed below described impact edits within the Encounter Data Front End System (EDFES) and are effective for encounter submissions beginning July 2, 2022.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Edits impacting all encounter records (Payer IDs 80881, 80882, and 80887) will be activated to prevent invalid characters being submitted in the Date Qualifier field (DMG01) and to prevent the submission of more than one Principal Diagnosis code per encounter record. Edits impacting Institutional encounter records (Payer ID 80881) will be activated to ensure blanks are not submitted in the Patient to Subscriber Relationship field (SBR02) and to prevent the submission of zero or zeroes in the Monetary Amount field when submitting line level adjustment reason codes. Edits impacting DME encounter records (Payer ID 80887) will be activated to prevent missing values in the Subscriber’s Street Address (N301) and to prevent missing values in the name of the Subscriber’s City (N401).
